PURPOSE OF FIRE-RATED CONSTRUCTION?

SUMMARY

Fire-Resistance-Rated (informally often called "fire-rated" construction), serves several purposes:

- Intention is to limit or slow the fire spread within the room of fire origin
- Allow more time for occupants to egress, more time to protect in place, and allow more time for firefighter response

Fire-Resistance-Rated construction is a passive fire protection system. Fire and smoke spread is to be limited without intervention and without relying upon the successful function of a system (like active systems such as fire alarm or fire sprinkler system).



Allow Time for Occupant Escape (Egress)



Allow Time to Protect-In Place (Area of Refuge within an interior exit stair)



Allow Time for Firefighter Response
(Buildings more resistant to fire can be stable for longerperiods of time)
